

YouTube – Searching – Videos with Closed Captions

Steps are illustrated in the screenshot below:

1. Go to [YouTube](https://www.youtube.com/)¹ (link opens in a new window) and enter search terms to find a video.
2. Select the **Filters** button.
3. Select the **Subtitles/CC** option.
4. On the list of videos, look for the **CC icon** below the video description.
