

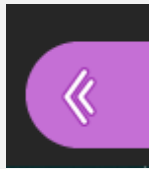

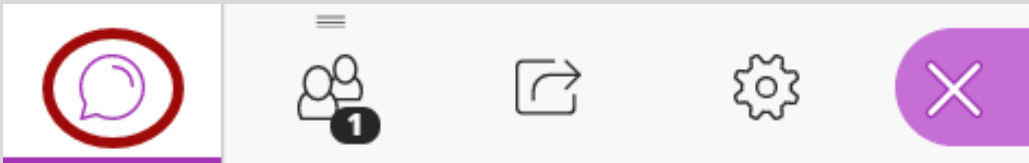

Open the Collaborate Panel for more settings.

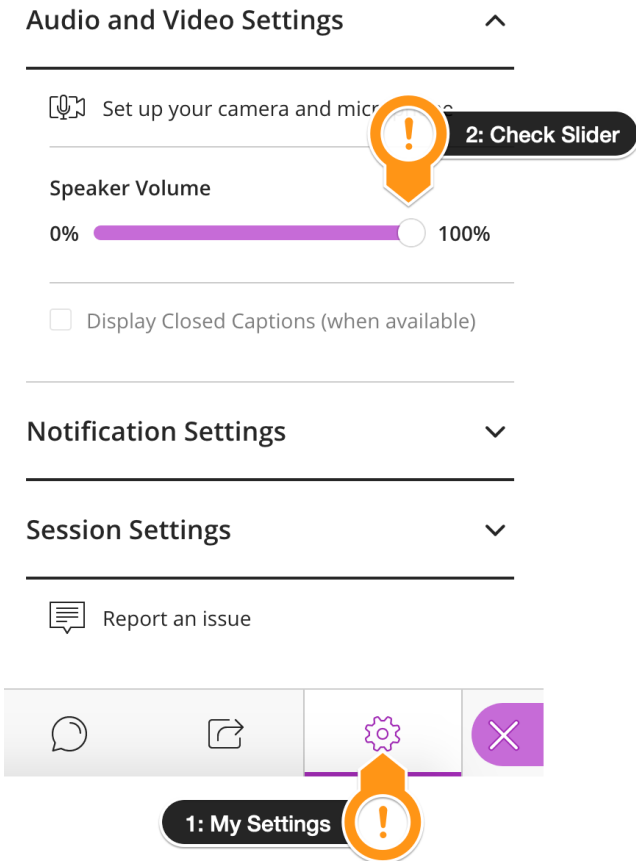


Select the Chat bubble (first icon) to open the Chat Panel.

What is Respondus?

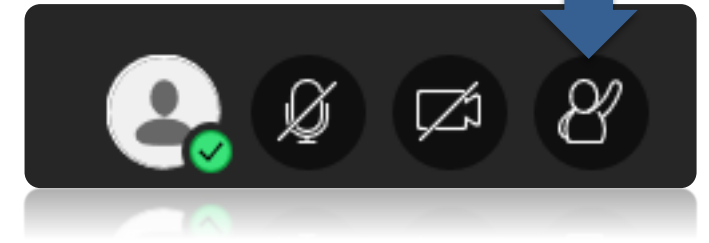
- An authoring tool that helps you create and manage exams.
 - Create assessments in Respondus for online courses
 - Import paper-based tests (Word, RTF, CSV)
 - Import from Blackboard
 - Publish to Blackboard
 - Import tests from publisher test banks
 - Print tests
 - Works offline, in a Windows environment
